Present perfect (1) (I have done)

We create it by means of HAVE/HAS + ...ED(I have worked. She has found it.)

Question form: **Has** she **found** it? Yes, she has

Negative form: No, she hasn't. No, she hasn't found it.

We use Present perfect to discribe situations in which:

1. We don't know (or we are not able to guess) the time of action

I have seen him - viděl jsem ho.

I have bought a new car. She has come to help us. Have your friends arrived?

2. The action started in the past has a result now

TODAY - I haven't seen her today.

THIS - I have been to England twice this year.

RECENTLY - She has got it recently.

- Would you like something to eat ? No, thanks, I have just had lunch.

3. We use present perfect with

 You have never told me about it. NEVER

EVER - Have you ever been to France?

Has she send the letter yet? No, she hasn't send it yet. ... JIŽ, UŽ- otáz /záp. JESTE NE..

SINCE (od) -- I haven't bee there since June. - I have lived here for 5 years.

- I applied for a job a week ago but they haven't replied so far. SO FAR

IN THE LAST FEW DAYS, YEARS – I have a lot of meetings in the last few days.

FOR A LONG TIME – I haven't seen him for a long time.

FOR AGES – I haven't eaten such a delicious meal for ages.

4. in the following type of sentences when we use superlative:

This is the first time (that) I have heard her sing.

This is the worst film I have aver seen.

This is the only party I have really enjoyed in my life.

5. after expression HOW LONG:

How long have you been there?

How long have you known him?

How long has she had this car?

What should have come to your notice: ! BE CAREFUL! or

JUST NOW – past tense : He felldownstairs just now.

...if you use the expression: He has just fallen downstairs.
